MAN retains position in Dow Jones STOXX Sustainability Index

It has been confirmed that MAN shares will retain their position in the Dow Jones STOXX Sustainability Index (DJSI STOXX) for the year 2004, the MAN Group having obtained a considerably better rating than in the previous year.

The pan-European DJSI STOXX lists only those companies which are leading in their field in terms of sustainability-driven business policies. MAN shares were first admitted to this Index for 2003. In addition to corporate strategy, the criteria include activities in the sector of environmental protection, as well as social commitment. Members of the Index are reviewed annually by analysts from Sustainability Asset Management (SAM Research) in Zürich.

The MAN Group published its first Sustainability Report in the spring of 2003, giving a detailed account of the Group's activities focused on the three "pillars" of sustainability, namely economy, ecology and social issues.
