



MAN sells mobile military-bridge activities to Krauss-Maffei Wegmann

Munich, April 11, 2005

The MAN Group has sold the mobile military-bridge activities (MAN Mobile Bridges GmbH) belonging to MAN Technologie AG to Krauss-Maffei Wegmann GmbH & Co. KG. The relevant agreement, which is still subject to Federal Cartel Office approval, was signed on 8 April 2005. This represents a further step by the engineering group MAN to dispose of peripheral activities and focus on its five core divisions.

The sale of MAN Mobile Bridges GmbH offers a partial solution for MAN Technologie AG, which is to be transferred entirely to another industrial environment. The company is mainly involved in the aerospace sector as a component supplier for the ARIANE 5 project.

In 2004, MAN Mobile Bridges GmbH achieved sales of some €19 million with ninety employees. Its major products are the LEGUAN bridge-laying system for tracked and wheeled vehicles and the PSB 2 high-speed bridge for Leopard 2 tanks.
