MAN Nutzfahrzeuge to supply a further 2,077 vehicles

The British Ministry of Defence (MoD) and MAN have reached agreement on delivery of a further 2,077 trucks. The two sides made this announcement at the Defence Vehicle Dynamics Off-Road Show in Bedfordshire, England, on 29th June 2006. The contract is to be signed within the next few weeks and is the exercise of an option that supplemented the main order for just under 5,200 trucks which MAN won in March 2005. The total value of the order has thereby increased by some €300 million (net) to around €1.6 billion. The additional order comprises mainly four-wheeler vehicles with some eight-wheelers. They will be delivered between mid-2007 and 2013.
